Character Breakdowns:

DUSTY

*Male (lead), any ethnicity, 25 - 30 years old - * **Must know how to play Guitar** **

Dusty is someone who doesn't really acknowledge how much time he exactly wastes. He's someone who, if he can, will put things off until tomorrow. He very much floats his way through life. He's not too sure of what he'll do in the future, nor does he care. At one point in his life, Dusty wanted to be a musician – he grew up playing the guitar and was actually very good at it. Over the years his passion for music has dwindled, particularly after he was denied acceptance to a conservatory to study music upon graduating high school. Since then, Dusty has adopted a “better to not try at all, than to try and fail” mindset.
